### We are very excited about the upcoming performances. We have a few very important items that we need you to know so PLEASE TAKE A FEW MINUTES TO REVIEW THIS LETTER.

- 1. Please make a checklist of everything needed for each dance and make sure you have everything before you leave home. Also, double check everything before you leave the Civic Center! If you lose something at the Civic Center, there is a table outside the stage door where all lost and found is placed. We do not take lost & found items from the Civic Center to The Dance Centre' (with the exception of after Saturday's performance).
- 2. See attached sheet for rehearsal days and times.

- 3. EVERYTHING MUST BE READY FOR REHEARSALS. Headpieces must stay on. Shoes must be clean and spray painted the proper color for your class. Be sure to have a back up pair of tights. Double knot shoe strings. NO eyeglasses on stage if possible. NO GUM!! And please girls, no underwear. BE SURE TO MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR NAME. Many people have the same items, so please remember to mark all of your pieces.
- 4. Our Dress Rehearsals will be limited seating. More to come as we get closer.
- 5. The evening performance begins at 7:00 p.m. Opening number dancers should be on stage warming up by 6:30 p.m. Petite Academy performers should be to the holding room by 3:30 p.m. on Saturday & show starts at 4:00.
- 6. Due to all the restrictions with Covid 19 we are going to use your cell phone and record your dancers during the show. We just ask you be considerate and not block anyone's view around you.
- 7. No dancers are to be outside the Civic Center. No dancers are to be in the lobby-except the audience for the shows. PLEASE DO NOT GO INTO THE LOBBY WITH YOUR COSTUME ON. You must wear a cover up.
- 8. All students must stay off the stairways and off the stage unless they are ready to go on. All dance classes must line up at least 3 dances before their dance. There will be a T.V. in the holding room & upstairs hallway for you to watch the show and keep track of when you need to line up.
- 9. The Green room is for QUICK CHANGES ONLY!! A quick change is for those dancers with only 2 -3 numbers in between their routines. Do not hang out in the quick change area. Only costumes that are being used during the quick change are to be in this area! There are designated dressing rooms upstairs for all other changes.
- 10. We ask that NO child be left without a parent or guardian. We can not be responsible for children dropped off.
- 11. There is a prop table back stage. Please keep props on the tables. Be sure to place props back on the table after your dance is done, so they are ready for the next performance.
- 12. No tap shoes on stairways or hallways. Please carry shoes before going on stage.
- 13. Directions to the Civic Centré. Take I-75 North from Wapak. Get off at the 309 exit. Follow signs for the Civic
- 14. It is of utmost importance that each of you are at the rehearsals and performances. This is the only way we can give you the BEST show!!! And it's going to be GREAT!
- 15. All your dancewear needs are available at Four Seasons Dance Shoppe. Hours are Mon. Thurs. 4-7:00pm or Friday's by appointment only. Recital hours Closed Mon May 31<sup>st</sup> Open Tues, June 1<sup>st</sup> – Thurs, June 3<sup>rd</sup> 1-6:00pm and Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup> 2-4p
- 16. The backstage area MUST be kept clear of non-essential personnel. Family members and friends are to wait in the

- 18. It is extremely important that everyone associated with the dance recital remain in the contracted areas and not roaming the building.
